

BLOOD DONORS NEEDED!

We are recruiting men and women to screen for glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase (G6PD) deficiency to donate blood that will be used in laboratory research. Generally, those at risk for G6PD deficiency are individuals of Mediterranean (e.g. those originating from Greece, Italy, Sardinia) or African descent. We are trying to develop drugs which are safer in people with G6PD deficiency. Financial compensation will be provided.

Who Can Participate?

Men and women between the ages of 18 and 62 who:

- weigh over 110 pounds
- are in good general health
- are not pregnant or planning to become pregnant within the next 12 months
- have no history of alcohol abuse or IV drug use


